



## Code of Conduct for Parents

I agree to the following expected standards of behaviour whilst supporting my child for Pickering Brook Netball Club:

- I will remember that my child plays for their enjoyment and development, it is their game, not mine or anyone else's.
- I will encourage my child to play within the rules and respect ALL officials and coaches.
- I will not use bad language, nor will I harass any players, officials, coaches or other spectators from either team.
- I will not criticise officials, team members or coaches in any way during or after the game. If I have a question or concern I will address the team manager during a break or after the game in a calm and respectful manner.
- I will remember that children learn from our example and I will applaud good plays by both my child's team and their opponents.
- I will give positive comments that motivate and encourage continued effort and performance, rather than winning or losing.
- I will agree to support the club and the coaches and provide assistance or volunteer my time when I am able.
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- I will respect and thank the coaches, officials and other volunteers who give their time to conduct this event for my child.
- If my child is unable to play or train I will advise the coach or manager at least 24 hours before the next game or training session.
- If I have a complaint to submit to KDNA, I will take the appropriate avenues through Pickering Brook Netball Club.
- In the event of an investigation resulting from potential breaches of this Code of Conduct, I will participate in that investigation as is necessary and accept disciplinary actions, if required, by Pickering Brook Netball Club and/or KDNA.
- I understand that my child's coach/s makes decisions in the best interests of the team regarding court time, player positions, player combinations etc. I will accept these decisions without argument.
- I understand that any misuse of a social media platform on netball or club matters, which includes comments or photos made about our club, an opposition player or club, club member or official which can be deemed improper, intimidating, racist, sexist or degrading will not be tolerated by Pickering Brook Netball Club.
